



HOTEL LAYOUT





HOW TO GET TO PUTRAJAYA MARRIOT HOTEL FROM KLIA?



The best way to get to the Putrajaya Marriott Hotel from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) is by car/taxi, as it is the fastest and most direct route.

Here are the directions and details for driving:

Driving Directions (Approx. 35 minutes)

- The journey covers approximately 40.6 km and typically takes about 35 minutes by car, depending on traffic.
- Start from Kuala Lumpur International Airport Terminal 1 (KLIA T1).
- Follow the main highways, primarily using Lbh KLIA/Route 26/E6 and then the Lebuhraya Putrajaya-Cyberjaya/Lebuhraya Putrajaya-Dengkil-KLIA/Route 29.
- The route involves several toll roads.
- Exit the highway towards Dengkil By-pass / IOI ResortCity.
- Follow the signage to the Putrajaya Marriott Hotel.

Quick Tip: Taxis, ride-sharing services (like Grab), and airport limousine services are all readily available at KLIA to take you directly to the hotel.

Via Car

From your nearest LRT station, take the train to KL Sentral LRT station, then switch to KLIA Transit and take the train to Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station. From there, take a taxi or a grab to Putrajaya Marriott Hotel.

Putrajaya & Cyberjaya Malaysia

From KL Sentral, take the LRT to Ampang Park LRT Station then switch to the Putrajaya line which will take you straight to the Putrajaya Sentral MRT. From there, take a taxi or a grab to Putrajaya Marriott Hotel





The **KLCC area** is a vibrant hub for shopping and dining, offering a lively atmosphere with diverse cultural experiences and nearby attractions like **Aquaria**. The area's centerpiece is the iconic **PETRONAS Twin Towers**, an architectural marvel featuring a skybridge and an observation deck with breathtaking views. For a different type of experience, visit the culturally significant **Batu Caves**, a site known for its stunning limestone formations and the magnificent golden statue of Lord Murugan, accessed by climbing its 272 colorful rainbow steps, a perfect opportunity for photography. Completing the modern skyline is the **TRX Exchange 106**, the tallest building in Malaysia, a commercial hub with a modern design and a reputation for offering exceptional fine dining experiences. All these attractions are easily accessible via public transport.

7. Hokkien Mee

Thick yellow noodles braised in a flavorful dark soy sauce with pork and prawns.



8. Hainanese Chicken Rice

Poached chicken and fragrant rice cooked in chicken stock, served with a chili and ginger sauce.



9. Cendol

A sweet, cold dessert with shaved ice, coconut milk, pandan jelly, and palm sugar syrup.



10. Rendang

A rich and dry slow-cooked meat curry with a complex blend of spices and coconut milk.

Royal Selangor Pewter



You can explore Malaysia's rich history of craftsmanship with a self-guided tour at the **Royal Selangor Pewter Factory & Visitor Centre**, where you can see how pewter is made and take a photo with the world's largest pewter tankard.

As a hub for Malaysian arts and crafts, the <u>Central Market</u> is a great spot to immerse yourself in local culture, where you can wander through stalls to find unique souvenirs and handcrafted items. For a peaceful escape, visit the **Perdana Botanical Garden**, a beautiful green oasis that is free to enter and is a great spot for photography.

For an easy way to explore the city, the <u>KL Hop-On Hop-Off Bus Tour</u> provides a fantastic way to see Kuala Lumpur's sights at your own pace. You can book a ticket on their official website.
