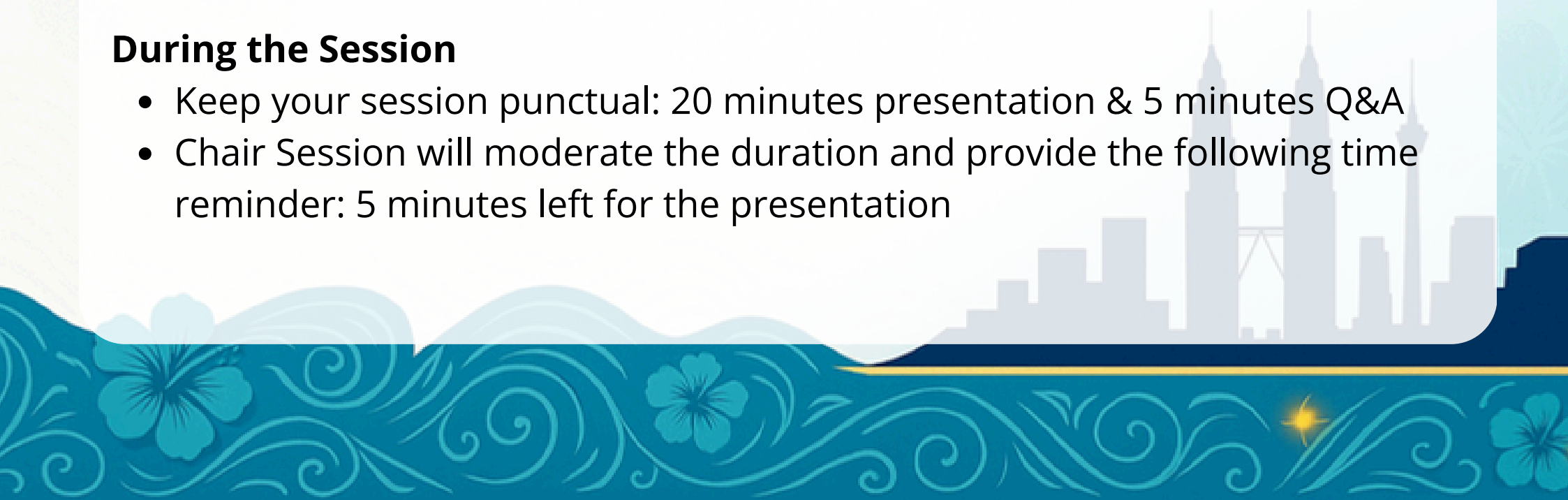

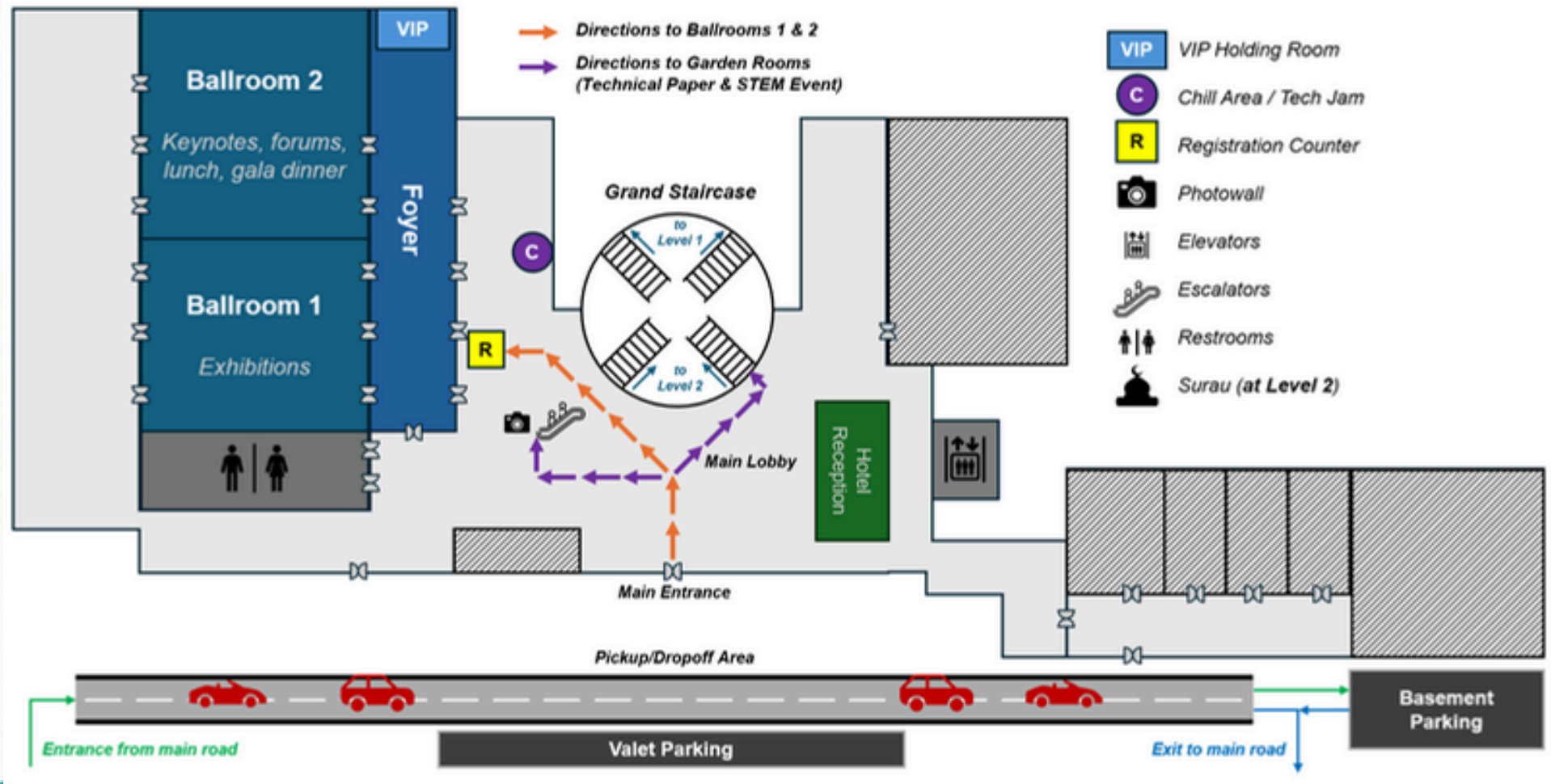

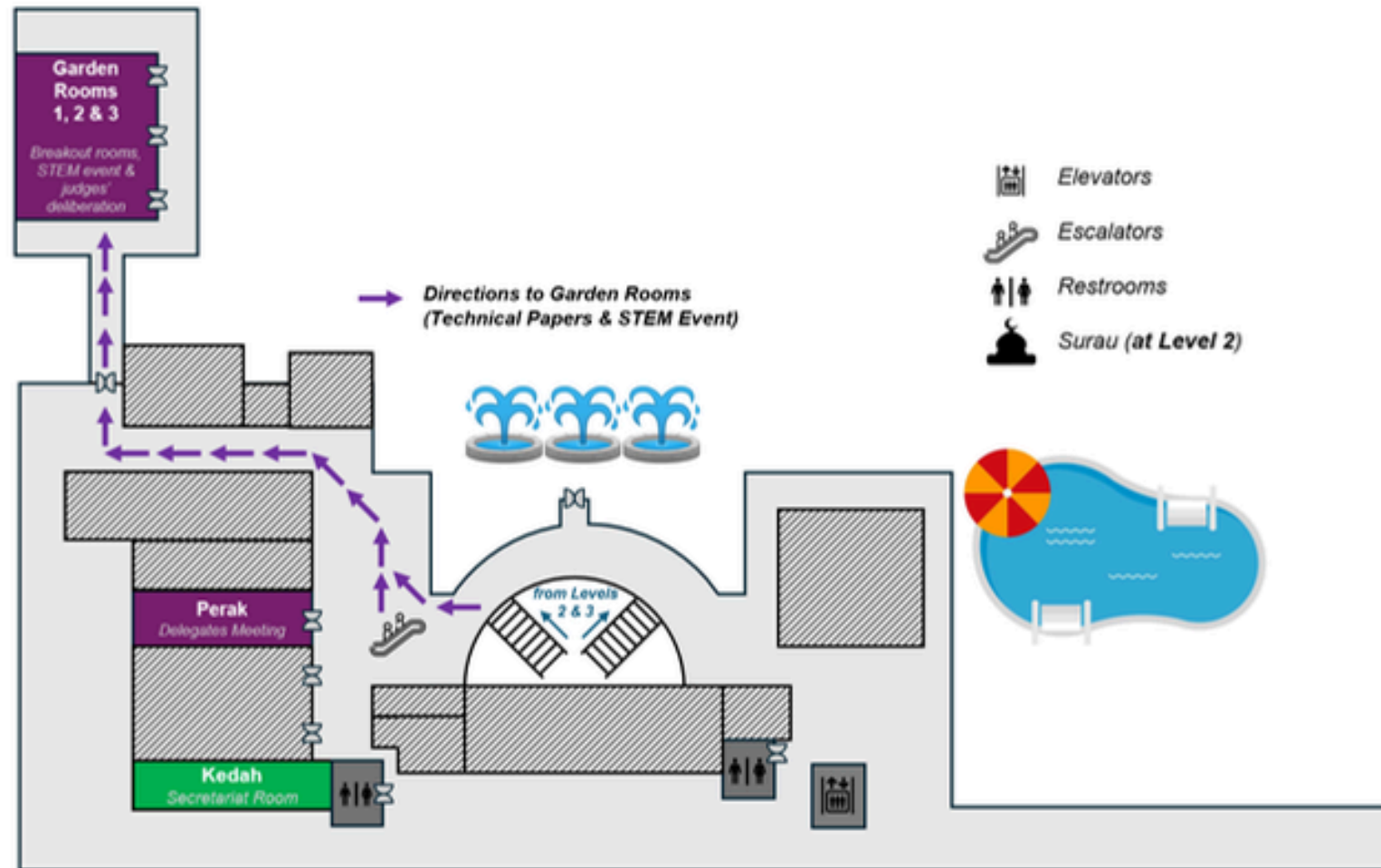

HOW TO GET TO PUTRAJAYA MARRIOTT HOTEL FROM KLIA ?



The best way to get to the Putrajaya Marriott Hotel from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) is by car/taxi, as it is the fastest and most direct route.

Here are the directions and details for driving:

Driving Directions (Approx. 35 minutes)

- The journey covers approximately 40.6 km and typically takes about 35 minutes by car, depending on traffic.
- Start from Kuala Lumpur International Airport Terminal 1 (KLIA T1).
- Follow the main highways, primarily using Lbh KLIA/Route 26/E6 and then the Lebuhraya Putrajaya-Cyberjaya/Lebuhraya Putrajaya-Dengkil-KLIA/Route 29.
- The route involves several toll roads.
- Exit the highway towards Dengkil By-pass / IOI ResortCity.
- Follow the signage to the Putrajaya Marriott Hotel.

Quick Tip: Taxis, ride-sharing services (like Grab), and airport limousine services are all readily available at KLIA to take you directly to the hotel.

A map showing the route is displayed below:

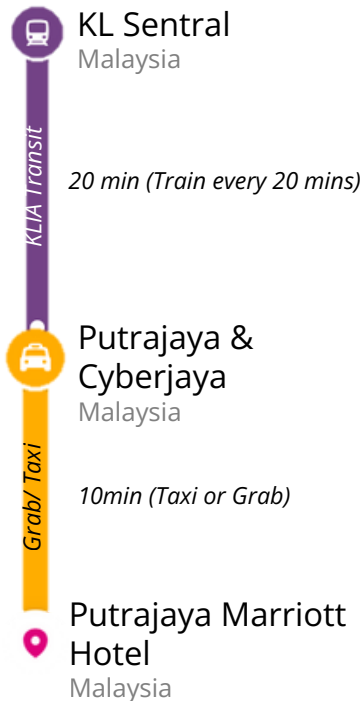


HOW TO GET TO PUTRAJAYA MARRIOTT HOTEL?



LRT + Grab/ Taxi

From your nearest LRT station, take the train to **KL Sentral LRT station**, then switch to **KLIA Transit** and take the train to **Putrajaya & Cyberjaya station**. From there, take a taxi or a grab to Putrajaya Marriott Hotel.



MRT + Grab/ Taxi

From **KL Sentral**, take the **LRT to Ampang Park LRT Station** then switch to **the Putrajaya line which will take you straight to the Putrajaya Sentral MRT**. From there, take a taxi or a grab to Putrajaya Marriott Hotel

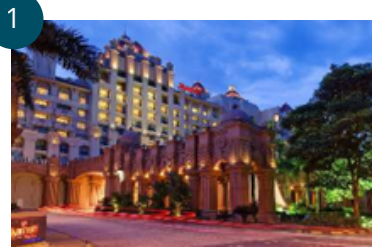

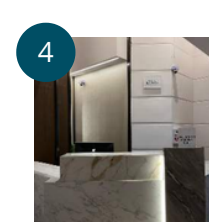

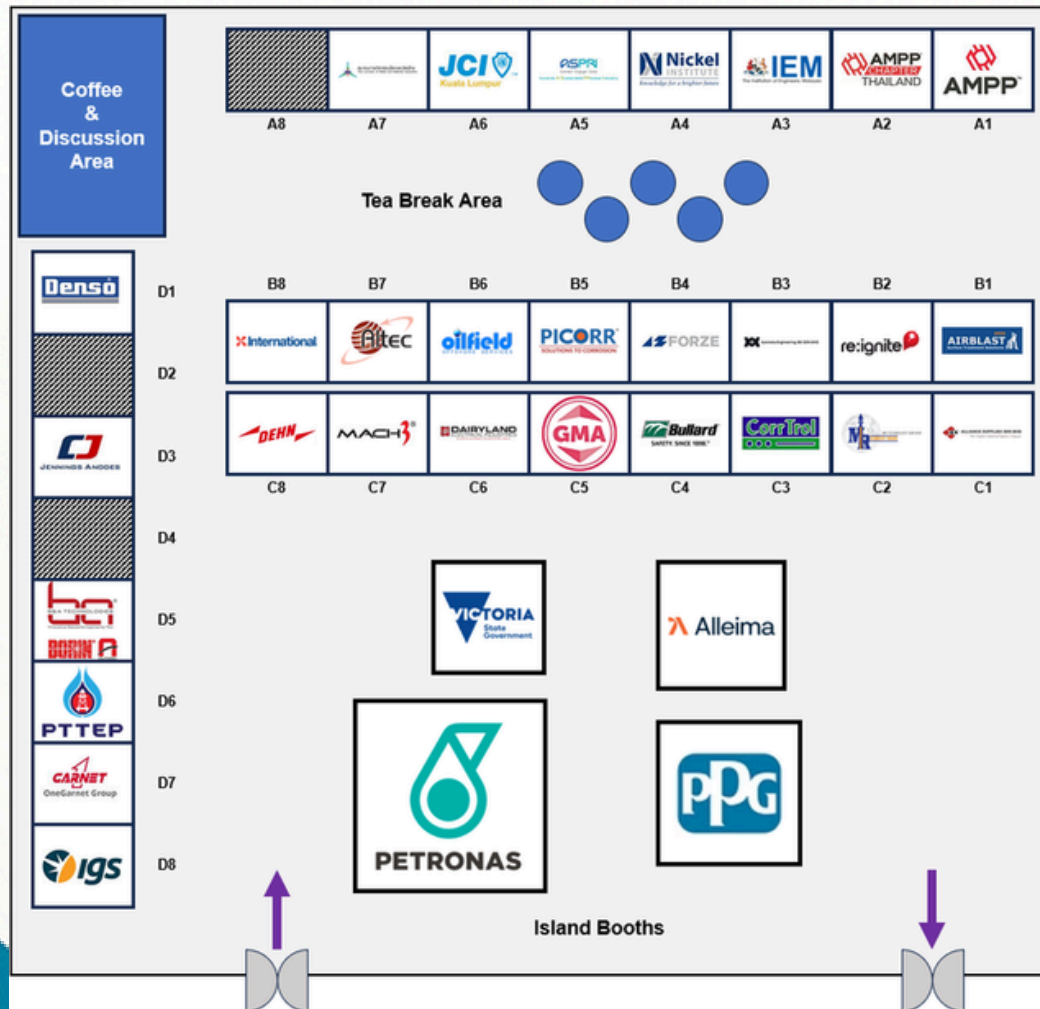

1. Teh Tarik

Malaysia's famous "pulled" milk tea, known for its frothy texture and smooth taste.



2. Nasi Lemak

Fragrant rice cooked in coconut milk, served with a spicy chili sambal, crispy anchovies, peanuts, and a boiled egg.



3. Laksa

A rich and spicy coconut milk-based noodle soup with chicken or prawns and tofu puffs.



4. Satay

Marinated and grilled meat skewers served with a sweet and spicy peanut sauce.



5. Roti Canai

A flaky, buttery flatbread cooked on a griddle, perfect for dipping in curry.



6. Char Kway Teow

Stir-fried flat rice noodles with prawns, cockles, egg, and chives in a savory dark sauce.



7. Hokkien Mee

Thick yellow noodles braised in a flavorful dark soy sauce with pork and prawns.



8. Hainanese Chicken Rice

Poached chicken and fragrant rice cooked in chicken stock, served with a chili and ginger sauce.



9. Cendol

A sweet, cold dessert with shaved ice, coconut milk, pandan jelly, and palm sugar syrup.



10. Rendang

A rich and dry slow-cooked meat curry with a complex blend of spices and coconut milk.

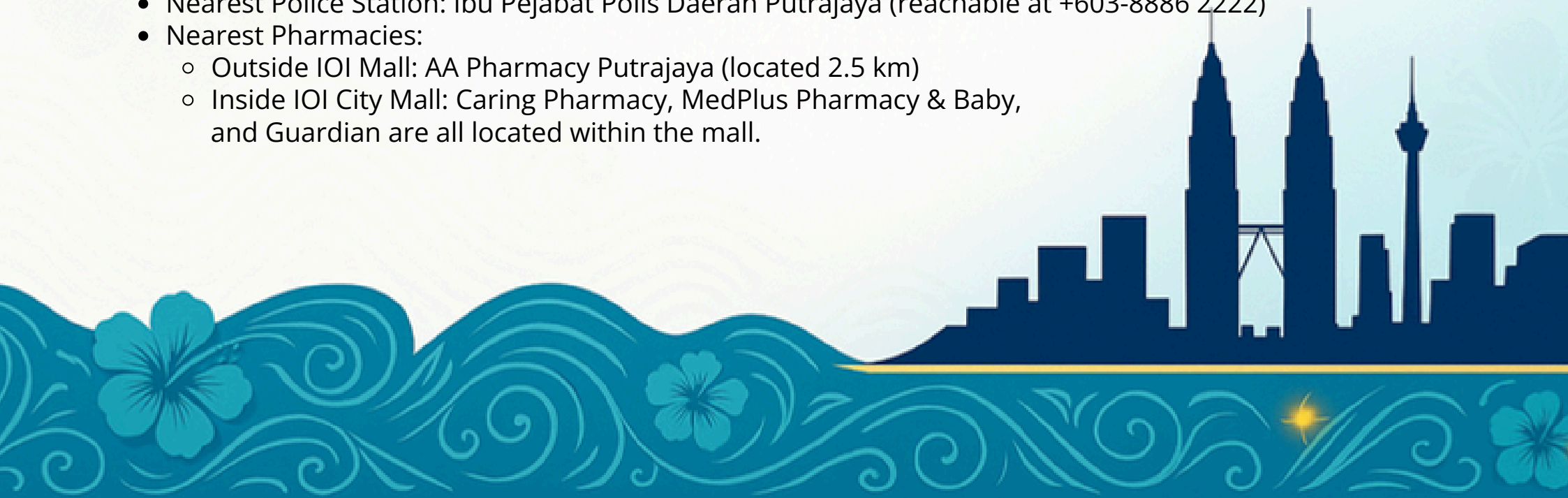
Registration Booth
